**Ask for a sign from the Lord, your God; let it be deep as the nether world, or high as the sky!**

**“... for nothing will be impossible with God.” Mary said, “Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.”**

For most of my adult life my family has had to face serious medical problems. We faced life or death issues a number of times. Twice in the last 6 months, we faced these issues. The hard part for me is the “May it be done to me according to your word.” In December, my husband came close to dying - in fact, his heart stopped at one point.
