

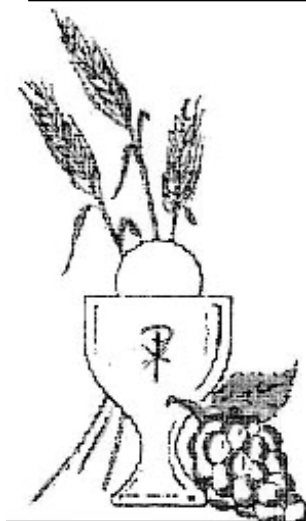

February 29th, March 1st, 2nd, and 3rd
7 to 8:30 pm - Mission Session in the Church
8:30 to 9:00 pm - Fellowship in the Cafeteria

A team of professional Catholic evangelists, a priest, and a layperson, will offer the four-night Parish Mission here at St. Joseph. The emphasis of the mission will be to invite Catholics into a deeper understanding of the Mass and to discover or strengthen your personal, living faith.

Blessed and Broken is a four day preached mission, focusing on the four parts of the Liturgy of the Eucharist. *Blessed and Broken* examines the scriptures as a source of understanding the beauty and power of the Eucharist. Each of the four mission sessions offer; preaching, song, and a simple ritual to express our praise and devotion to Jesus as the Bread that was blessed and broken; as the wine of eternal life. Finally, we too are invited to communion with Christ as we claim this heritage for ourselves.

Session One:	<i>All are Blessed and Welcome</i>
Session Two:	<i>Breaking Open the Word</i>
Session Three:	<i>As Bread that is Broken</i>
Session Four:	<i>Blessed to go Forth</i>

THE JUNIOR LEGION OF MARY CELEBRATING 15 YEARS AT ST. JOSEPH

On November 14, 1988 the 1st Junior Legion of Mary was held at St. Josephs. The Junior Legion of Mary is an organization that is open to youth 6 to 17 years of age and is dedicated to self-sanctification through the prayer and the rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The juniors meet every week around Mary's statue and have a simple prayer meeting that includes the rosary. A report is also given on the prior week's work accomplished for Jesus.

Some of these past reports included:



- Helping and praying for others in need.
- Visiting and helping the less fortunate or sick - cleaning a sick person's home.
- Learning the Ten Commandments and the Saints of the Church.
- Making rosaries that were sent to the troops in Iraq and to poor foreign missions around the world: Korea, Africa, India, Russia, the American Indians, South America, and prison inmates.
- Running a Teen Legion of Mary booth at World Youth Day '93 in Denver and gave out 18,000 rosaries, 5,000 Miraculous Medals, and promoted Mary's legion to Russia, Lebanon, Africa, Western Europe, South America, and Asia.
- Helping in soup kitchens at the Salvation Army in St. Charles and the Missionaries of Charity of Blessed Mother Teresa in St. Louis.

Last May and also in many other years the juniors crowned the Blessed Mother in a very special first Saturday devotion and led the rosary for everyone after Mass.

Juniors are encouraged to remember and discuss the Gospel reading each week. Some juniors have a good grasp of the important parts of the New Testament their discussions help to form the habit of listening and praying at Mass. A holy card is the junior's reward if they can remember the Gospel which is then pasted in their own memory album as a keepsake to remember their years in Mary's Legion.

This organization will encourage your children to learn to pray on their own and become more thoughtful of others. We are proud to mention that former Junior Legion of Mary members at St. Josephs were Seth Jansen, now studying to be a priest at Kenrick Seminary, a junior member for six years, and John O'Brien, a junior member for over two years, was chosen by the St. Louis Archdiocese to study for the Priesthood at North American College in Rome, Italy. Both Seth and John (John's parents now reside in Lake St. Louis) have stated that being a member of Mary's Legion was a major factor to their call to the Priesthood. Other former legion members, whether male or female, have expressed their gratitude for all that Mary's Junior Legion has offered them over the last fifteen years toward their spiritual life.

Recently we sent our hand made rosaries (80) to the troops in Iraq. Each week we continue to make rosaries, and now would be a very good time for your child to join the Junior Legion of Mary.

We invite your child or teen to become a member of Mary's Legion. All you need to do is come: (It will help the shy child if they come with another friend, or sibling. (The mother is also welcome to stay until the child feels at home with the setting.)

Where: Multipurpose building basement. (The little house with green shutters behind the rectory.)

When: Every Tuesday at 3:15pm to 4:45pm. (A snack is provided for hungry youngsters as soon as they arrive at the meeting.) If your child needs a ride home we will be able to take them home.
