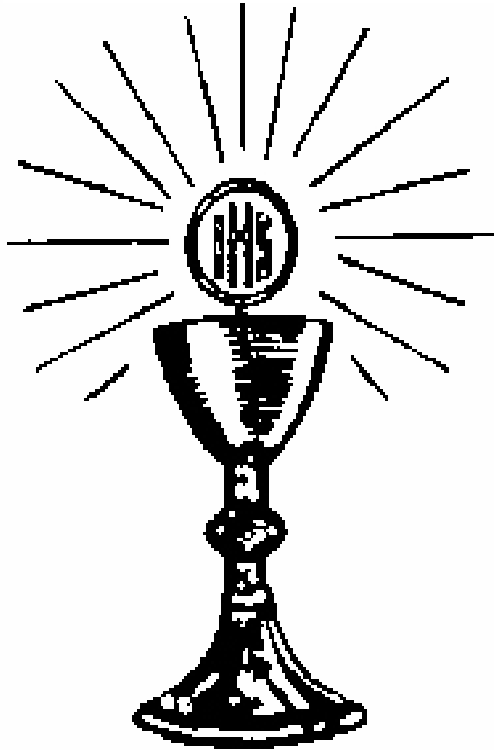




## ***EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION***

### ARCHDIOCESAN LENTEN REGULATIONS

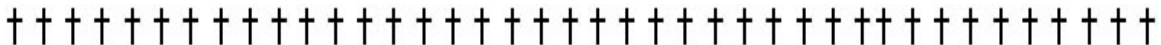
*Then to all Christ said, "Whoever wishes to be my follower must deny his very self, take up his cross each day, and follow in my steps." (Lk 9:23).*

The Church has always helped us fulfill these words of Jesus by prescribing very definite penance for all Catholics. Accordingly, the Pope and the American bishops have outlined obligatory fast and abstinence as follows:

**Ash Wednesday (February 9) and Good Friday (March 25) are days of abstinence for all Catholics over the age of 14.** On these two days, **fast** as well as **abstinence** is also obligatory for those **from the ages of 18 to 59.** Abstinence means abstinence from meat. Fast means one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing between meals (liquids are permitted). No Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation.

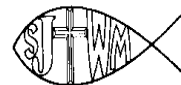
**All other Fridays of Lent** are days of **abstinence** from meat. Here again Catholics will not hold themselves lightly excused, but if there were a serious health problem, this obligation would not apply.

We should strive to make all days of Lent a time of prayer and penance.

## Registration Schedule for the 2005/2006 School Year:

**February 11 – February 18** - Registration of students currently enrolled St. Joseph School.

**March 3 – Kindergarten Tours** – 1:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Please call: 441-0055 – ext 200 – to make reservations for the evening tour. Day tours need no reservations.

**March 4 – Kindergarten Tour** – 9:00 a.m.

**March 11** – Applications for new kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students – Applications will be accepted on this date for all grade levels from 8 to 10am. and 2 to 6pm. in the school cafeteria. No application will be finalized until all steps have been completed. This process is not on a first come-first served basis. If all necessary documentation is provided, the process should only take a short time.

This is a three-part process:

1. Submission of the application to St. Joseph School with all documentation.
  - a. Copy (for school's files) of Birth Certificate
  - b. Copy (for school's files) of Baptismal Certificate
  - c. Social Security Number
  - d. \$200.00 Application Fee (non-refundable)– per student
  - e. Signed release for records from previous school and a copy (for school's files) of the last report card.
2. Student academic assessment testing for grade level.
3. Interview with the assistant principal (parent and student).

The criteria for admission in St. Joseph School is as follows:

Families applying to St. Joseph Catholic School must demonstrate to the Administration (pastor/principal) a desire for the special kind of school where Catholic teaching and moral formation are an integral part of the school philosophy and environment. This includes:

- a. Participation in the spiritual and community life of the parish or respective congregations.
- b. Support of the concepts upheld in the Parish Witness Statement.
- c. Agreement and willingness to follow the policies and procedures of St. Joseph School and the Arch. of St. Louis.
- d. Willingness to financially support the Parish/school.
- e. Willingness to cooperate with the teachers and administration in the moral, psychological, emotional, spiritual, intellectual and academic development of their children.
- f. For admission into kindergarten, children must be 5 years of age by August 1, 2005.

For admission into first grade, children must be 6 years of age by August 1, 2005.

The Principal will place the student in a class according to his/her level of achievement and needs. Admission and grade placement will be determined by the results of screening tests, standardized achievement scores, report card, and records from the previous schools attended and by the school's ability to meet student's needs. If there are more qualified applicants than openings available, a waiting list will be formed.

**March 21-22-23** – New Kindergarten Screenings – Appointment times will be assigned at the time of application. No screening appointments will be given to incomplete applications.

### Attn: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

We are implementing numerous liturgical directives that were recently published in the General Instruction of Roman Missal. Following are some of the new liturgical directives as they apply to Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:

- All vessels must be purified as soon as possible after consummation of the precious blood. We have a carafe of water available at the credence table for purification.
- We designate two Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (there is an asterisk by your name on the schedule) for each mass to wash the cups in the working sacristy after mass.

These liturgical changes will expand our ministry of Holy Communion to the St. Joseph parish family, as well as free up valuable time of our Priests and Deacons.

## PROJECT RACHEL MARKS TWO DECADES! AND THE MINISTRY IS EXPANDING.

As this year marks the 20th anniversary of Project Rachel, the Church's ministry to those who grieve past abortions, several post-abortive women in the Archdiocese of St. Louis are doing what they can to further the local ministry. In addition to the free individualized counseling service that Project Rachel currently offers, a committee was formed earlier this year and has developed two new efforts: (1) a spiritual support group which is now meeting and (2) several retreats which will be offered starting in Spring 2005.

Funding for these efforts was provided by the Archbishop Joseph Naumann Endowment Fund, which was established earlier this year as a way to support the archdiocese's post-abortion ministry.

"We are really excited because Project Rachel is growing and the women are doing wonderful work within the committee," said committee member, Marisol Pfaff. *In His Name* is a spiritual support group for post-abortive women that meets once a month. The group is modeled after the New York Sisters of Life monthly support group for post-abortive women, that includes Eucharistic adoration and a Scripture-based format.

Pfaff stressed that the group is confidential and does not publicize the location of meetings. Even though some of the women are speaking out about their abortions, some of them are still within their own private healing. *In His Name* does not offer therapy but instead the opportunity to grow spiritually. "We say spiritually because all of us try to bring it back to the Lord. We do a lot of praising the Lord, thanking Him for His forgiveness and mercy," said Pfaff. "And at the same time, we're also letting out some of the pain and hurt from previous years."

The committee has also organized the first Project Rachel retreat for post-abortive women which will be offered March 12, 2005. The daylong retreat is modeled after the Sisters of Life "Entering Canaan" retreat program for the post-abortive. "Each person, no matter what they have done, is to be cherished and loved as a unique reflection of God's love," said Pfaff. In addition to the healing opportunity it offers each participant the retreat will also offer Eucharistic adoration, opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and Spiritual Mass. The Sisters of the Society Devoted to the Sacred Heart will lead the retreat, as well as a counselor, a priest, and a lay facilitator. Weekend retreats are currently being developed and will be offered later next year, Pfaff indicated.

Project Rachel was founded by Victoria Thorn of Milwaukee in 1984. Today, the ministry is thriving in 140 Catholic dioceses in the United States, as well as, in dioceses in other countries.
